

Care Based Incentive Measure: SBIRT Claims Update

The Screening Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) Care Based Incentive (CBI) measure is for screening adults 18 years and older for alcohol misuse and providing persons engaged in risky or hazardous drinking with brief behavioral counseling interventions to reduce alcohol misuse.

Primary care providers (PCPs) may offer SBIRT to members as long as they meet the requirements outlined on the SBIRT Tip Sheet, which can be accessed by navigating to the Measure Specific Resources section of the Care Based Incentives Resources page of the Alliance provider website at

Update: Claims for these services should only be submitted to the Alliance.

- * Services that are billed to Beacon Health Options (Beacon) will not qualify for CBI payment, and all claims must be submitted to the Alliance under the PCP's NPI. Please note that Beacon may not reimburse for these services since they are intended to be a primary care service.
- * In order to receive CBI payment, the SBIRT service must be performed and billed to the Alliance by the linked PCP's office. SBIRT services performed by behavioral health therapists under the same clinic NPI as the linked PCP will be awarded CBI payment.
