



Important Information Regarding CHDP Transition

The Alliance has received clarification from the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) in regards to the The Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) program transition.

Please note that **the PM 160 will remain in effect until further notice** and there will be no change in the billing process for CHDP claims at this time. The CHDP transition is anticipated to occur no later than mid 2018.

What this means for providers:

- * Continued use of the PM 160 for billing the CHDP wellness visits to the Alliance;
- * Continued use of the CHDP codes on the PM 160;
- * Continued contracted payment rate of 200% of the Medi-Cal rate in effect on the date the Covered Service was provided;
- * For providers who are utilizing the services of eCDHP, these services will continue to be offered until further notice.
