

HbA1C Data Submission Tool is Available!

The Alliance is excited to announce the launch of the new Data File Submission Tool (DST). This tool was created to support providers in submitting HbA1c results from their electronic health record for the calculation of the Care Based Incentives (CBI) Program's Diabetic HbA1c Good Control <8.0% measure. Submitting data is optional, but it is recommended to ensure that complete data is reported for this measure.

The Diabetic HbA1c Good Control <8.0% measure reports on the percentage of members with diabetes whose most recent HbA1c value was less than 8.0%:

- * Members 18-75 years of age who had a HbA1c test during the calendar year
- * Most recent HbA1c test if it had a result of <8.0%
- * Members identified as having diabetes during the measurement year or the year prior may be included in this measure
- * Identification of members with diabetes:
 - o Claim/encounter data
 - o Pharmacy data
- * HbA1c test result

Note: Providers submitting their Alliance members' HbA1c results will increase performance in the Diabetic HbA1c *Testing* measure as well. Members that have been tested but do not have a test result value on file will be reported as being in poor control.

The DST is now available on the Alliance's Provider Portal (the Portal) under "Data Submissions". A DST Guide is also available on the Portal, which details step by step instructions, the information required, and how to upload. An email confirmation will be sent within one business day after each successful data submission.

Diabetic HbA1c Good Control <8.0% and Diabetic HbA1c Testing are programmatic measures that are paid annually. Please note the following deadline for submitting data:

Measurement Period	Submission Due Date
January 1, 2017 – December 31, 2017	January 31, 2018
