



Provider Preventable Conditions: New Reporting Requirements

Effective May 15, 2017, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) updated the requirements for reporting Provider Preventable Conditions (PPCs). When a PPC is identified, providers are required to complete the following procedures in reporting each PPC:

- * Report to DHCS via their secure online reporting portal, available at <https://apps.dhcs.ca.gov/PPC/SecurityCode.aspx>
- * Send a copy of the submission to **PPC@ccah-alliance.org**
- * Retain a copy of the submission in your clinic's records.

Additionally, the Alliance is now also required to screen encounter data to identify and report PPCs.
