Reminder: 2017 HbA1c Data Submission Deadline

The deadline to submit HbA1c data for calendar year 2017 is January 31, 2018. This tool was created to support providers in submitting HbA1c results from their EMR/EHR for qualification of the CBI Diabetic HbA1c Good Control <8.0% measure.

As the deadline approaches, please review the following:

- * If your file was previously rejected, please resubmit. If you have any questions regarding why the file was rejected, please contact your Provider Services Representative.
- * Diabetic HbA1c Good Control <8.0% CBI measure uses the most recent HbA1c test; please upload the remaining data for dates of services from January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017.

As a reminder: Qualifications for the Diabetic HbA1c Good Control <8.0% CBI measure:

- * Members 18-75 years of age who had a HbA1c test during the calendar year
- * Most recent HbA1c test had a result of <8.0%
- * Members identified as having diabetes during the measurement year or the year prior may be included in this measure
- * Identification of members with diabetes:
 - o Claim/encounter data
 - o Pharmacy data
- * HbA1c test result

NOTE: In addition, by submitting members HbA1c results your site will qualify for the Diabetic HbA1c Testing CBI measure as well.

The Data Submission Tool (DST) is now available on the Alliance's Provider Portal under "Data Submissions". A Data Submission Tool Guide is available on the Provider Portal that has step by step instructions on the information required and how to upload. An email confirmation will be sent within one business day after your data submission.

The Diabetic HbA1c Good Control <8.0% and Diabetic HbA1c Testing are programmatic measures and are paid annually.
