## Compounded Prescriptions

### **Baclofen, Lansoprazole, Metronidazole, Omeprazole, and Vancomycin**

While First Kits are available for Baclofen, Lansoprazole, Metronidazole, Omeprazole and Vancomycin, First Kits do not have National Drug Codes (NDCs) recognized by MedImpact, the Alliance's Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM). Therefore, claims for these medications cannot be processed like other pharmacy claims, regardless of prior authorization. To remove barriers to care when a liquid form of one of these medications is required, the Alliance is collaborating with two Specialty Walgreens locations, listed below, to compound these drugs for our members. Compounded medications will be available to fill by in-store pick up or free home delivery. To request that Walgreens compound Baclofen, Lansoprazole, Metronidazole, Omeprazole or Vancomycin for an Alliance member, please follow the steps below:

1. Call or fax the prescription to one of the Walgreens Specialty locations listed below:
